#### SOCIAL AND ENVIRONMENTAL SAFETY PROCEDURES' SENSITIZATION CONCLUDED



Mr. Cherno Ceesay, the Social and Environmental Safety Officer for FIOHTG's ongoing WB School project has concluded a six day sensitization on the social and environmental safe guard procedures that must be observed by workers and stakeholders on the sites. The sensitization took place in Sare Futa, Fugam, Korrop, among others. The programme is meant to mitigate potential negative impacts on the physical and social environment, thereby protecting the communities and workers on the ground.

#### GBV SENSITIZATION IN WORLD BANK FUNDED PROJECT SITES



A sensitization on gender based violence and violence against children has been held in Bush Town, Takong Kunda, Mujumba, Sare Nyanga, Kerr Aulde and Timpa. The villages constitute project sites where FIOHTG is implementing a WB project to construct schools and classrooms. Discussions included what constitutes child labour and the penalties, harassment, rape among others. This is intended to protect children and women in the communities and to also ensure that contractors and labourers adhere to standards and leave no harm on communities.

# SDU ON PEACEBUILDING SENSITI-SATION



The School Development Unit has embarked on a sensitization tour for peacebuilding. The programme is targeting students, teachers and school administrators. It is envisaged that the training of children and their educators promotes peaceful coexistence but also has a trickling effect in communities in the long run. If children can be taught to understand peace, conflict resolution and peaceful coexistence, they can grow up as peaceful adults.
